



## **LAIS Special Educational Needs Policy (October 2015)**

As the Lower Austrian International School is a selective high school for semi-professional athletes we generally do not have students with special educational or physical needs. Nevertheless, as a public building, the school follows Austrian law and is therefore accessible for people (e.g. injured students, visitors ...) with impairments as it is equipped with the following features:

- An orientation system for blind people including an information board and signs in Braille writing
- Two disabled parking spaces
- Two elevators
- One toilet for the disabled on every floor (equipped with emergency buttons)

Since the school year 2014/15 the school has one integrated class including one student with permanent physical impairments. This is an exception and the student brings his own carer to school.
